A Transitions Program by FCIL

MoveDE is a transition program that assists individuals age 18 and older to move from a long-term care facility (e.g. nursing facility, hospital, or ICF-IID) into a home and community-based setting.

The program provides transition services and supports to individuals whether or not they enroll on a Medicaid waiver.

What are the program requirements?

To be eligible, an individual must be:

- Be 18 years of age or older
- Have income to sustain community living
- Participate in a needs assessment and have a need for the program
- Have care needs that can be adequately met in a community setting

How do I learn more and apply?

Individuals & Family members/guardian will work with the long-term care facility and MoveDE transition staff to apply, discuss options and coordinate services and supports.

What services and supports does the program offer?

Transition Coordination, which may include:

- Collaboration with discharge planners and care team to determine service and supports needed in the community
- Finding housing
- Coordinating Community Transition Services
- Identifying other community resources

Community Transition Services,
which may include:

- Security deposits and rental expenses required to obtain a lease
- Essential household items
- Fees and deposits for utilities and other services (e.g. phone, electricity, gas, water)
- Moving expenses
- Pre-transition transportation
